## Russell LaVerne Morse

January 4, 1929 - August 2, 2016

"And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to myself, that where I am, there you may be also." **John 14:3**

Many of you already know of the death of our good friend and co-worker, LaVerne Morse on August 2nd. His funeral service was conducted at Christ's Church, in Mason, Ohio.

He is survived by his wife Lois, five grown children, twenty grand-children, a sister, Ruth Margaret Johnson and countless friends around the world. All will miss him greatly. We rejoice because he has received his reward and is with the Lord. His brothers Eugene and Robert preceded him in death.

I first met LaVerne shortly after I became director of Gospel Broadcasting Mission. Not only was he a member of the legendary Morse missionary family in SE Asia, he also taught and promoted missions for 23 years at Cincinnati Bible Seminary. Many of the men and women he sponsored for training during those years, have become respected Christian leaders in SE Asia today. He and Lois also founded Asia Christian Services which continues its work of reaching and teaching tribal people in Asia. (see other side)
